District Information:

The Millard Public Schools District is located in the southwest area of Omaha, Nebraska. This predominantly suburban, residential district serves over 23,000 students, includes twenty-five elementary schools, six middle schools and four high schools. The Millard School District has the reputation of being among the finest school districts in the state and nation. Students consistently score well on national standardized tests. The district has AA Accreditation, the highest recognition awarded by the Nebraska Department of Education. Millard South is also accredited by the North Central Association of Schools and Colleges.

School Information:

Millard South High School has been located in its current building at 14905 Q Street for over 46 years. Thirty-two years ago, Millard High School became Millard South High School.

Millard South operates on an A/B semester block schedule with two grading periods each year. Credits are assigned to classes at five (5) credits per course per semester. Class periods are 92 minutes in length.

Millard Public Schools offers four Career Academies for high school students. Students can apply for a two-year program in Education, Entrepreneurship, Health Science, and Distribution & Logistics Management Academies during their sophomore year.

Early College High School:

Millard South offers an Early College program that is open to all high school students within the Millard Public Schools District regardless of their home school assignment. Students in the Early College Program earn a Millard diploma while also fulfilling the requirements for an Associate of Arts Degree/ Liberal Arts Academic Transfer at Metropolitan Community College.

Faculty:

Of the 149 certified teachers on staff, 116 hold advanced degrees. Student/teacher ratio is 15:1; student/counselor ratio is 367/1.

Students must earn a minimum of 230 credits in order to graduate from Millard South High School. The subject areas and the minimum number of credits a student must earn in each area are listed below:

Class Rank & Grade Point Average:

Rank in class is determined for grades 9 through 12 by the Mark-Point-System listed above. All courses are weighted equally with the exception of Advanced Placement Courses which are weighted and receive an extra five mark points. Each student's class rank information is located in the upper left hand corner of the transcript.
