 - ✓ Listen to each question (blue bubble). Answer the question by clicking on the white bubble and talking into a microphone. Once you record your response, the bubble turns orange. You can click on it to listen to your response. No special software is required.
 - ✓ If you make a mistake, mouse over the top corner of the now orange bubble and click the "X". It "empties" and you just start over (with that bubble).
 - ✓ Submit using an email you prefer for me to contact you at also use your full name. This is how you get credit for doing the exercises.

IMPORTANT:

- *Wait until summer begins to work on this. It is meant to keep your Spanish fresh over the summer not cross off your checklist now.
- *Some questions are objective (right/wrong answer) and some are subjective (open-ended, required an educated opinion/analysis/judgment).
- *Give as thorough an answer as possible. If your answers are all only a sentence or two and/or show little thought, your grade will reflect it.
- *I realize summer plans don't always allow for this, but it is ideal that you NOT try to do this all at once, spacing it out to keep Spanish fresh in your mind, rather than trying to do it all at the last minute. Not to mention sometimes with recording, there are technical difficulties. As you have all summer, NO exceptions will be made in such cases. Do NOT wait until the last minute!
